LEGAL AID & LEGAL REPRESENTATIVES: THE CRIMINAL CASES REVIEW COMMISSION

Having been granted unique access to CCRC data, researchers at the University of Sussex are undertaking important new research on the impact of legal aid cuts on applications to the CCRC.
