Confirmation of AAMR Roll out date in England

Following the successful rollout of Alcohol Abstinence and Monitoring Requirement (AAMR) in Wales on 21 October 2020, AAMR will go live in England on **31**st **March 2021.** This will be a full national rollout across the country on the same day.

AAMR is a new community sentence that bans individuals from drinking alcohol for up to 120 days and is supported by alcohol monitoring tags, a new and innovative form of electronic monitoring for the MoJ.

The Business Change team in the Electronic Monitoring programme are working closely with representatives across NPS, CRCs and HMCTS to ensure that our stakeholders are ready and feel confident in using this new tool and in supporting individuals who will be wearing the tag.

Awareness sessions have already commenced in most regions and will ramp up over the coming weeks. We will be supporting the delivery through virtual Teams sessions and further information will be cascaded using existing channels before Go live.
